Michael A. Cane — Director

Securities-lawyer director biography (the “Michael” identity)

Mr. Cane became a director of Las Vegas Gaming on July 5, 2001. From May of 1989 to June of 2001, Mr. Cane was the President and Chief Executive Officer of Tele-Lawyer, Inc., a Nevada Corporation that was acquired in an exchange agreement with Legal Access Technologies, Inc., a publicly reporting company, headquartered in Las Vegas, Nevada. At that time, Mr. Cane became the Chairman of the Board and CEO of Legal Access Technologies and continues to act in that capacity. Mr. Cane also maintains a law practice limited to Securities Law in Las Vegas, Nevada with six other attorneys, under the name Cane & Company, LLC.

Mr. Cane attended the University of California, Irvine where he graduated top in his class and received a B.A. degree in Economics (June 1975). He received his Juris Doctor degree from the University of Southern California School of Law in May of 1978, also receiving high honors. Among these honors were Order of the Coif, Phi Beta Kappa, Summa Cum Laude, Dean’s Honor List, Who’s Who in American Colleges and Universities, Recipient of Three University of Southern California Scholarships, The American Jurisprudence Award in Constitutional Law and member of the University of Southern California Law Review.

He is a licensed member of the Nevada, Washington, California and Hawaii State Bars, the U.S. Tax Court and maintains Real Estate Broker licenses in Nevada, California and Hawaii.

Curriculum Vita, U.C. Irvine doctoral dissertation (the “Castro” identity, 2024)

Kyleen Elisabeth Castro received her B.A. degree in Economics from the University of California, Irvine in 1975 (Phi Beta Kappa, Summa Cum Laude, Dean’s Honor List, Who’s Who, ASUCI Vice President for Academic Affairs) and her Juris Doctorate (J.D.) from the University of Southern California, Gould School of Law in 1978, where she was Order of the Coif, recipient of The American Jurisprudence Award in Constitutional Law, a member of the University of Southern California Law Review, and recipient of three University of Southern California Scholarships — the identical 1975 B.A. and 1978 J.D. with the identical honors recited in the 2001 Cane biographies.

She later returned to the sciences, earning an M.S. in Tumor Biology from Georgetown University in 2019 and a Ph.D. in Molecular Biology and Biochemistry from the University of California, Irvine in 2024, with certificates in Clinical Research Conduct and Management (U.C. Berkeley Extension), Genetics and Genomics (Stanford), and Cell and Molecular Biology (UNLV). Her dissertation curriculum vita lists, under “Licenses Obtained,” only the State Bars of California, Nevada, Washington and Hawaii, together with an instrument-rated helicopter and fixed-wing pilot certificate; it recites no real-estate broker license — the broker licenses advertised in the 2001 Cane biographies are conspicuously absent from the 2024 Castro curriculum vita.²

Her legal career recites the same path as the 2001 Cane biographies: clerk for Justice Robert Thompson on the California Court of Appeals, an associate with Goodsill Anderson and Quinn in Hawaii, a Partner with the Newport Beach firm of Wellman and Cane, an Associate Professor of Business Law and Chairman of the Department of Financial Economics and Institutions at the University of Hawaii, and a Professor of Law at Whittier College and Western State University. She founded and managed the continuous Las Vegas securities practice operating successively as Cane and Company, Cane O’Neill Taylor, Cane & Associates, and Cane Clark, LLP, and now manages Westward Law, LLC from the same 3273 East Warm Springs Road office. She lists herself as President and CEO of Tele-Lawyer, Inc. and its successor Legal Access Technologies, Inc. — the same two public companies named in the 2001 Cane biographies.

She has published articles on the same legal topics — Corporate Take-overs, Tax Sheltered Investments, structured personal-injury settlements, land-sale contracts, the Flat Tax System, and accreditation of medical schools — and authored four books (Divorce, Taxes, Bankruptcy and Estate Planning) in the *Five Minute Lawyer* series. In the sciences she is co-first author of a 2022 *Cell Cycle* article on synthetic lethality in clear cell renal cell carcinoma and author of the 2024 U.C. Irvine doctoral dissertation. She presently serves as Director of Clinical Trials.²

The 2024 Curriculum Vita is appended to a University of California, Irvine doctoral dissertation in molecular biology, submitted as **Kyleen Elisabeth Castro**. It nonetheless recites, item-for-item, the 1975 U.C. Irvine economics degree, the 1978 USC law degree with identical honors, the same seven legal-article topics, the same *Five Minute Lawyer* book series, the same University of Hawaii and law-school professorships, and the same two public companies named in the 2001 “Michael A. Cane” and “Kyleen E. Cane” biographies: **Tele-Lawyer, Inc.** and **Legal Access Technologies, Inc.** No three distinct people share a 1978 USC law degree, the Order of the Coif, an identical seven-topic legal-publication list, an out-of-print 1995 book series, and the presidency of the same two reporting companies. All three biographies describe one person.

D. Name-usage chronology and its discrepancies. Cane represented to the SEC that the change from Michael A. Cane to Kyleen E. Cane took effect **June 28, 2001** — sixteen days after the June 12, 2001 Tele-Lawyer / Dynamic Associates reverse merger. The record contradicts that date and traces the later adoption of the Castro name:³

A \$575,000 mortgaged home purchase as “Michael A. Cane” in August 2003 — requiring government-issued identification and identity verification — cannot be reconciled with a legal name change two years earlier. The June 28, 2001 date was backdated to make the new identity appear to coincide with the foundational reverse merger. The “Kyleen Elisabeth Castro” name surfaces about fifteen years later in the Nevada Secretary of State annual filings for Cane’s own entities, the same period in which she undertook the doctoral studies in Molecular Biology and Biochemistry at the University of California, Irvine that produced her 2024 Ph.D. dissertation.

Cane” (Dec. 2002–Sept. 2003), an August 25, 2003 \$575,000 home purchase as “Michael A. Cane,” the May 19, 2004 quitclaim deed transferring that home from Michael to Kyleen (Clark County Doc. No. 200405190004721), and the July 22, 2004 Form 5 disclosing the change 1,120 days after the claimed date (Accession No.

0001255294-04-000216). The actual change was ordered by the Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County, Nevada on **November 25, 2003** (*In re Michael Allan Cane*, Case No. D308221, Dept. E; recorded Nov. 9, 2004 as Doc. No. 20041109:001972). The June 28, 2001 date was backdated to align the identity split with the foundational reverse merger.⁸

CONCURRENT IDENTITIES — NEVADA ENTITY & COURT FILINGS (2019–2023). The Castro identity is not a successor to the Cane identity; the two were used *simultaneously*, selected by audience. As “K E Castro,” the subject filed the Annual List as Manager of **Westward Law, LLC** (Entity E0259632015-7) on May 24, 2019, and as Manager of **DKM Development, LLC** (Entity E0527452005-8) on August 16, 2021 — both from 3273 East Warm

Springs Road. Within the same window and from the same address, the subject transacted as “Kyleen Cane”: filing as Manager of **World Series of Golf, LLC** (Entity E0068082014-8) on June 4, 2019 — eleven days after the Castro filing — and reaffirming that record on the December 20, 2023 reinstatement; emailing Mark Phillips on April 16, 2020 under the Cane name; and swearing the April 10, 2023 *Affidavit and Renewal of Money Judgment* as “Kyleen E. Cane, Esq., Nevada Bar No. 5900” in *Cane v. Phillips*, No. A-16-743194-C (Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County), to renew a \$4,888,924.78 judgment against Phillips. The subject thus presented to the Secretary of State as Castro and to the District Court as Cane contemporaneously, from one office — choosing the legal name that best suited each forum.⁹
